This series of work began when I started living in Kangra valley, Himachal Pradesh. Here, the senses are assailed with an all pervading natural beauty and human existence hardly seems intrusive.

This journey is an endeavour to capture and render the wondrous play of light and colour of this pastoral valley etched out against the sublime Dhauladhar mountain ranges.

The challenges lay in trying to express these fleeting elusive moods of nature - the rolling dark monsoon clouds, sunlight playing hide and seek, the stark winter landscape, luxuriant foliage, wise old trees - all characters in this natural drama.



Madhabi has a Bachelor's degree in Fine Arts from the College of Art, New Delhi. She has been awarded the United Nations Fellowship and Silver Medal in her final year. She also has a post graduate degree in History of Art from the National Museum Institute, New Delhi and has been awarded a research grant scholarship of 1994-95 for the Indian Collection at the Victoria Albert Museum, England, by the Nehru Trust.



Previous exhibitions include 'Vignettes of Ladakh' in May 2000 and 'Images' in October 2002 both held at Lalit Kala Academy. Annual exhibitions at the College of Art, New Delhi 1992-98; Yuva Mahotsav 1989-92 and an exhibition cum demonstration of Glass Painting in 1993. Madhabi has been a visiting lecturer at the College of Art, New Delhi 1995-98; South Delhi Women's Polytechnic 1995-98 and the Institute of Fashion Technology, Lucknow in 1999. She is currently working as a rural art instructor with Bal Bhawan in Himachal Pradesh.
